

Mosaic Freeschool is seeking 1-2 experienced **Upper Elementary** age group instructors to join our team for the 2022-2023 academic year. We are an education center serving homeschooled students in Central NJ. Our program meets in person one day/week for 30 weeks throughout the academic year, September through May.

We are seeking one or more individuals that can develop and lead two classes this fall:  
**Literature** - a discussion-based class that requires demonstrated expertise in language arts/literary analysis/foundational writing instruction for elementary to middle school-aged students. Strong organizational and planning skills along with the ability to connect with students to engage them in reading, stories, and a love of literature are essential.

**Ancient History** - a project and discussion-based class that requires prior experience working with upper elementary-aged students and a passion for and knowledge of history. This is a hands-on class that will involve reading, research, discussion, and both group and individual project work.

The ability to teach across other upper elementary and middle school subject areas is strongly desired, as is the ability to collaborate effectively with other educators to develop future classes. NJ teaching certification is not required.

The ideal candidate may or may not come from a traditional teaching background but *must*:

- have proven success teaching upper elementary and/or middle school-aged children
- have a genuine passion for and command of the subject matter
- possess excellent communication skills with students and peers
- deliver project-based, student-centered, differentiated instruction
- be an intellectually curious, lifelong learner that desires to take their teaching practice in innovative directions
